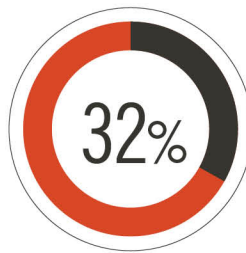

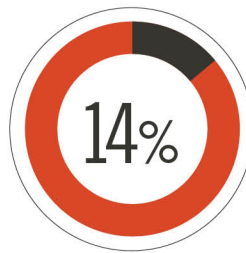
Since 2000, major publications have issued five rankings in which Tuck has placed #1 eight times, in the top five 26 times, and in the top 10 55 times.

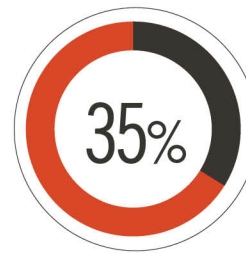
