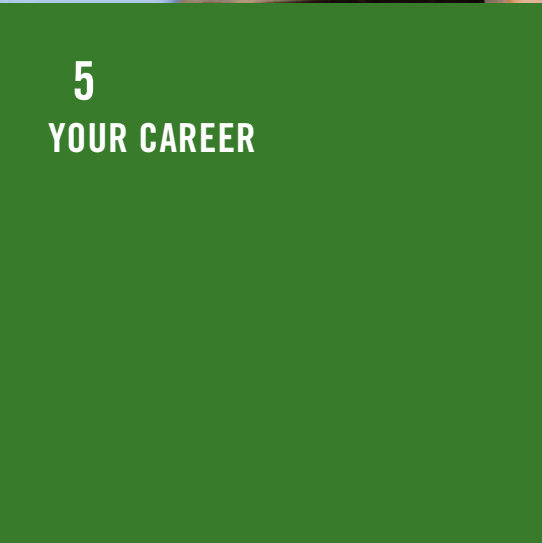

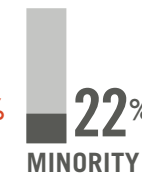
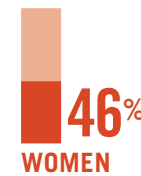

Student Demographics

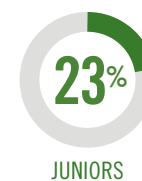

Your Application

We accept applications from undergraduates who have completed their freshman year at the time of application, and from recent graduates with less than one year of business-related experience. First-year undergraduates, business majors, and graduates with more than one full year of business-related experience, will not be considered.

Financial aid packages, in the form of scholarships or loans, are rewarded after admittance to the program. Limited full scholarships are available.

Candidates are encouraged to apply as early as possible to secure the program of their choice. A nonrefundable deposit of \$1,000 is due upon acceptance.

- Online application including 2 essays and your current resume
- Undergraduate transcript(s)
- SAT/ACT scores (waived if applicable)
- One faculty letter of recommendation
